Les Vignes de L'Eglise, Vermentino IGP Pays d'Oc 2017, 12.5% abv

Clean and bright, this aromatic wine is full of vibrant fresh fruit. Aromas of peach, mango, pineapple and pear intermingle and follow through onto the palate which is balanced and long.

Herdade do Peso, `Sossego` Vinho Regional Alentejano Branco 2020, 13% abv

Pale lemon in colour. The wine is bursting with fragrant aromas of ripe lemon and lime blossom, with subtle tropical notes of pineapple and mango. On the palate a lively acidity carries the bright fruit flavours onto the crisp and refreshing finish.

Famille Perrin, Luberon Blanc 2020, 13% abv

Pale lemon in colour, this wine has delicate notes of white flowers and citrus fruit on the nose. The palate is well-balanced with aracy acidity that perfectly complements the stone fruit and saline flavours, which linger on the finish.

Red

Baron de Badassière, Carignan IGP Côtes de Thau 2019, 13% abv

This wine is bright red in colour with deep purple hints. The nose is aromatic and lifted, with cassis, plum and herbs giving way to spice and a touch of game. The palate is medium to full with attractive berry fruit intensity, fresh acidity and firm but smooth tannins.

Château des Antonins, Bordeaux Supérieur 2016, 13% abv

Deep ruby-red in colour, this wine has an inviting bouquet of red plum, black cherry and blackcurrant, with hints of spice. The palate is concentrated and supple, with smooth tannins and layers of bright red fruit.

Bodegas LAN, Rioja Crianza 2017, 13.5%

This wine is intense cherry red in colour. Aromas of ripe strawberries, raspberries and cranberries are framed by subtle notes of vanilla and spice. On the palate, the wine is full bodied with silky tannins and a bright acidity which carries the aromas onto the lingering finish.

Rose

Monrouby, Grenache Rosé IGP Pays d'Oc 2018, 12.5% abv

Pale salmon in colour, this refreshing Provençal style rosé is brimming with fragrant red berry fruit, with notes of cherry, strawberries and raspberries and a hint of dried herbs. The palate is fresh with crisp acidity and a smooth finish

Sparkling

Papet del Mas, Cava Brut NV, 11.5% abv

Pale gold in the glass with fine bubbles. The bouquet is youthful, with apple and lemon aromas. On the palate, the Cava is light and well-balanced with a fine acidity and a fine mousse. Rounded and elegant, it has a lingering finish with hints of candied orange.

Devaux, Grande Réserve NV, 12% abv

The wine has a lovely Pinot Noir richness on the nose, with aromas of baked apples and vanilla. On the palate, it is full, rounded and well balanced, with a lively, persistent finish.
